 - a. Notice of Assessment
 - b. Proof of Income Statement
- For musicians over the age of 18, the most recent statements issued by Canada Revenue Agency, for the musician:
 - a. Notice of Assessment
 - b. Proof of Income Statement
- Letter outlining your need, and how you and/or your family benefits from participation in the WYO.

Please submit **one application per family**, even if you have more than one child participating in the WYO.
